DEFINITION:

Command and Control Style of Leadership is about Direction, especially under pressure. Situations of pressure reflect the extent in which we are attuned to and connected with our Essential Vibration; and test us as to what we are becoming.

Inner Leadership puts us in a permanent state of ‘becoming’, engaged in perpetual motion, always moving, deepening, evolving.

To the extent that we can consciously generate movement towards greater balance, the more our Command & Control leadership will reflect power, rather than force.

Power is the manifestation of Vertical Leadership in the Horizontal Dimension. It’s the direct result of living in the ‘critical axis,’ balancing personality and leadership styles effectively.

Force is the manipulation, commanding and controlling of the Horizontal Dimension. It results from a state of being trapped in the personality with ineffective leadership awareness.

Command & Control Leadership is represented by the center of a circle, which is the source from which the circle is drawn. Without the center, there is no circle. Without direction, there is no leadership.
